RESULTS OF EXAMINATION

Exhibits 1, 2, 5, 10, 22, 24, and 25 were examined and processed for the presence of identifiable latent prints with positive results:

- Exhibit 1: Three (3) latent prints were noted on the adhesive side of the tape.
- Exhibit 2: One (1) latent print was noted on the adhesive side of the tape.
- Exhibit 5: Two (2) latent prints were noted on the side of the metal cartridge.
- Exhibit 10: One (1) latent print was noted on the adhesive side of the tape.
- Exhibit 22: Two (2) latent prints were noted on the adhesive side of the tape.
- Exhibit 24: One (1) latent print was noted on the adhesive side of the tape.
- Exhibit 25: One (1) latent print was developed on the adhesive side of the tape.

The inked fingerprints and palm prints of Harris (Exhibit K-1) and Klebold (Exhibit K-2) were compared to the recovered latent prints. Identifications were made, as follows:

- Exhibit 1: The three (3) latent prints were identified as the left middle finger, left index finger, and right middle finger of Harris.
- Exhibit 2: The latent print was identified as the left index finger of Harris.
- Exhibit 5: The two (2) latent prints were identified as the right palm of Klebold.
- Exhibit 10: The latent print was identified as the left index finger of Harris.
- Exhibit 22: The two (2) latent prints were identified as the right index finger and left index finger of Harris.

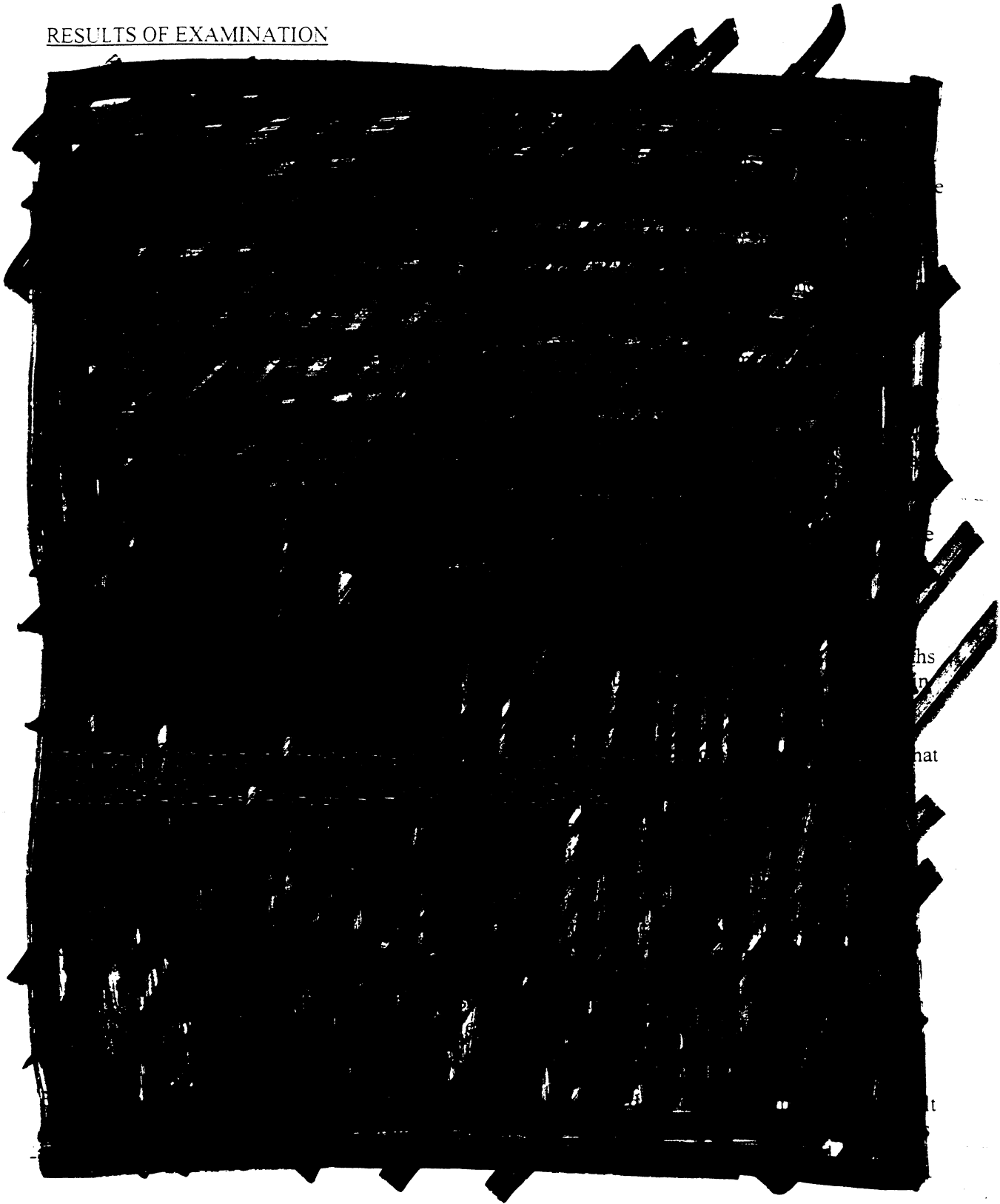

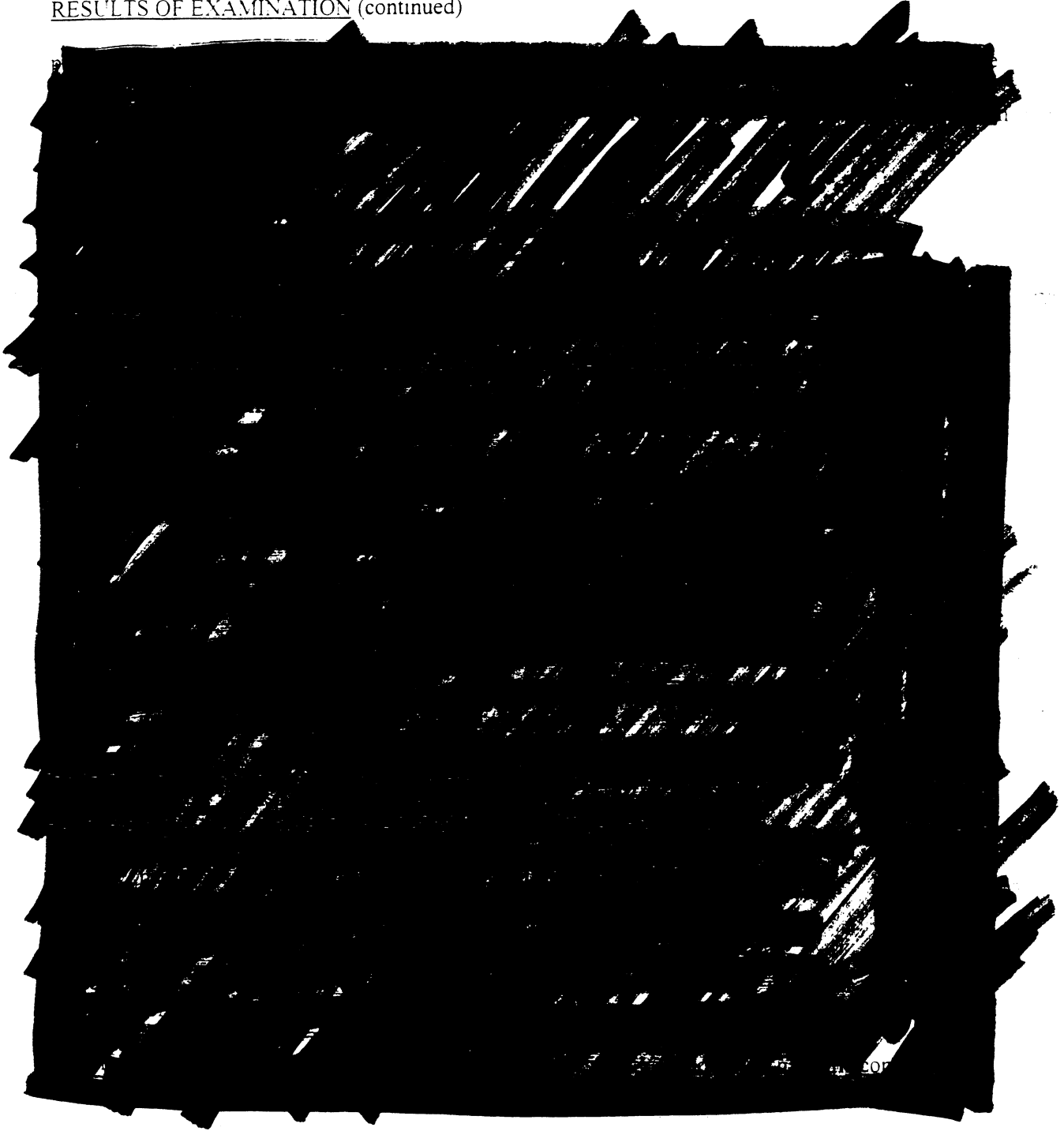

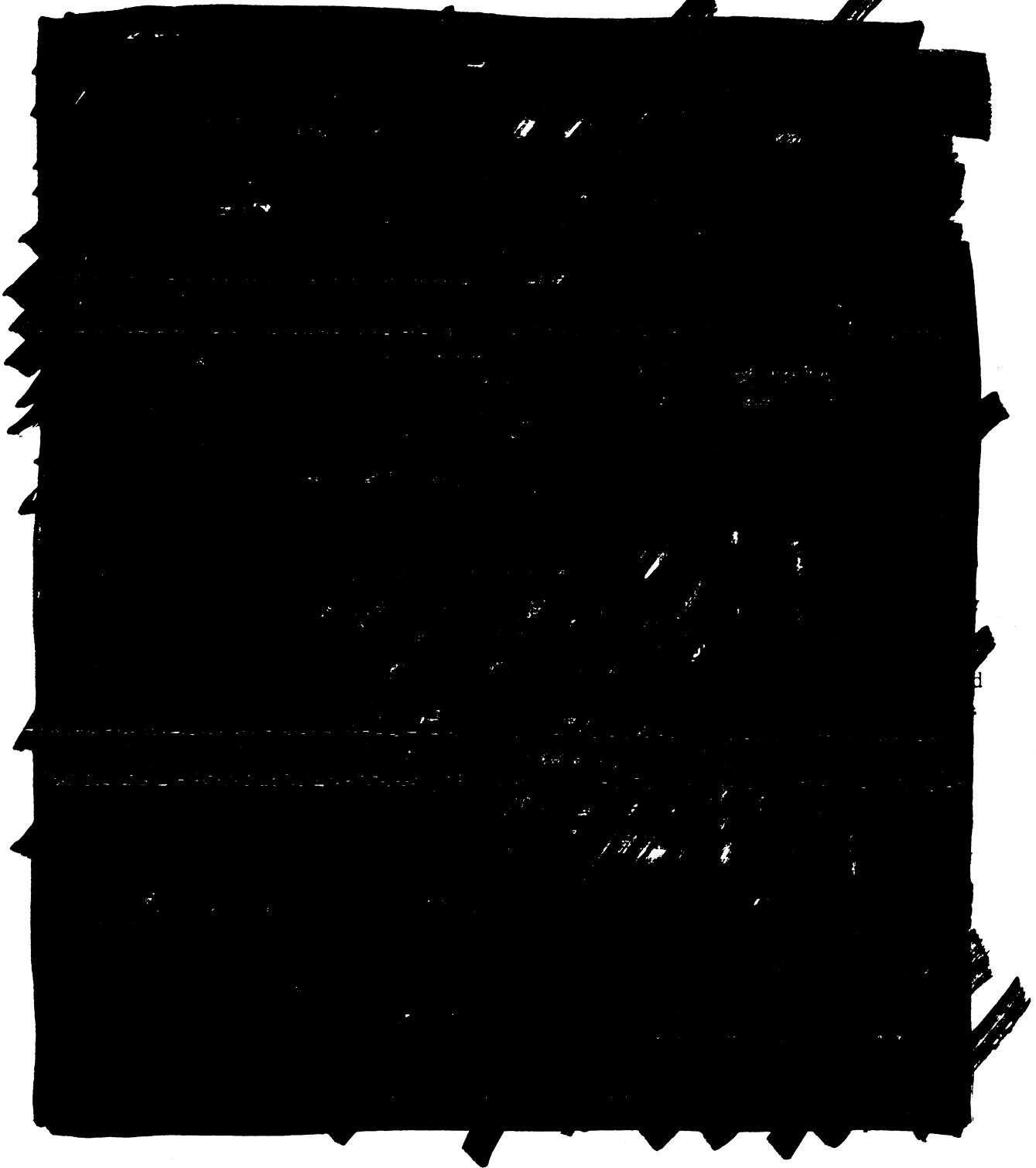
