REMARKS:

The following reports are those for the teams designated as Team One through Team Five for processing the scene and vehicles associated with Columbine High School. Other teams also involved were team Six, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, who handled the two deceased victims on the grounds, the cafeteria, and the area around the building; Team Seven, the Denver Police Department, who processed the administrative offices and attended all autopsies; and Team Eight, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, who handled the explosive evidence and the school parking lot on the southwest.

The reports for Teams One thorough Five represent the combined efforts of over thirty professionals from eight law enforcement agencies. Those agencies assisting the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office included the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (Denver, Pueblo and Montrose Offices); the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office, the Wheat Ridge Police Department; the Arvada Police Department; the Greenwood Village Police Department; the Thornton Police Department, and the Littleton Police Department. All team leaders reported to Jefferson County Sheriff's Office Laboratory Supervisor Chris Andrist. Scene processing began after the school interior was deemed safe to enter according to explosive experts. The processing began Wednesday, April 21, 1999 and essentially concluded Thursday evening, April 29, 1999.

Teams One through Five worked with representatives from and for the Jefferson County Coroner's Office for the recovery of the bodies of eleven victims in the school and the bodies of Harris and Klebold. Team members also exchanged information directly with the five forensic pathologists who performed all of the autopsies. Summary data for these five teams is given on the chart on page 4.

The enclosed five narratives and photologs for Teams One through Five detail the activities of each team. Each photograph sleeve is numbered to denote the team, the roll of film and the exposure. A set of scaled diagrams for the library (processed by
