On April 20, 1999, Investigator Gary Clyman, of the Colorado Attorney General's Office, was assigned to assist an investigation by the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office regarding multiple homicides, which occurred that date at Columbine High School, 6301 South Pierce Street, Littleton, County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, on April 20, 1999. Located at the crime scene was an explosive device shown to Investigator Clyman by Investigator Glenn Grove, of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office.
