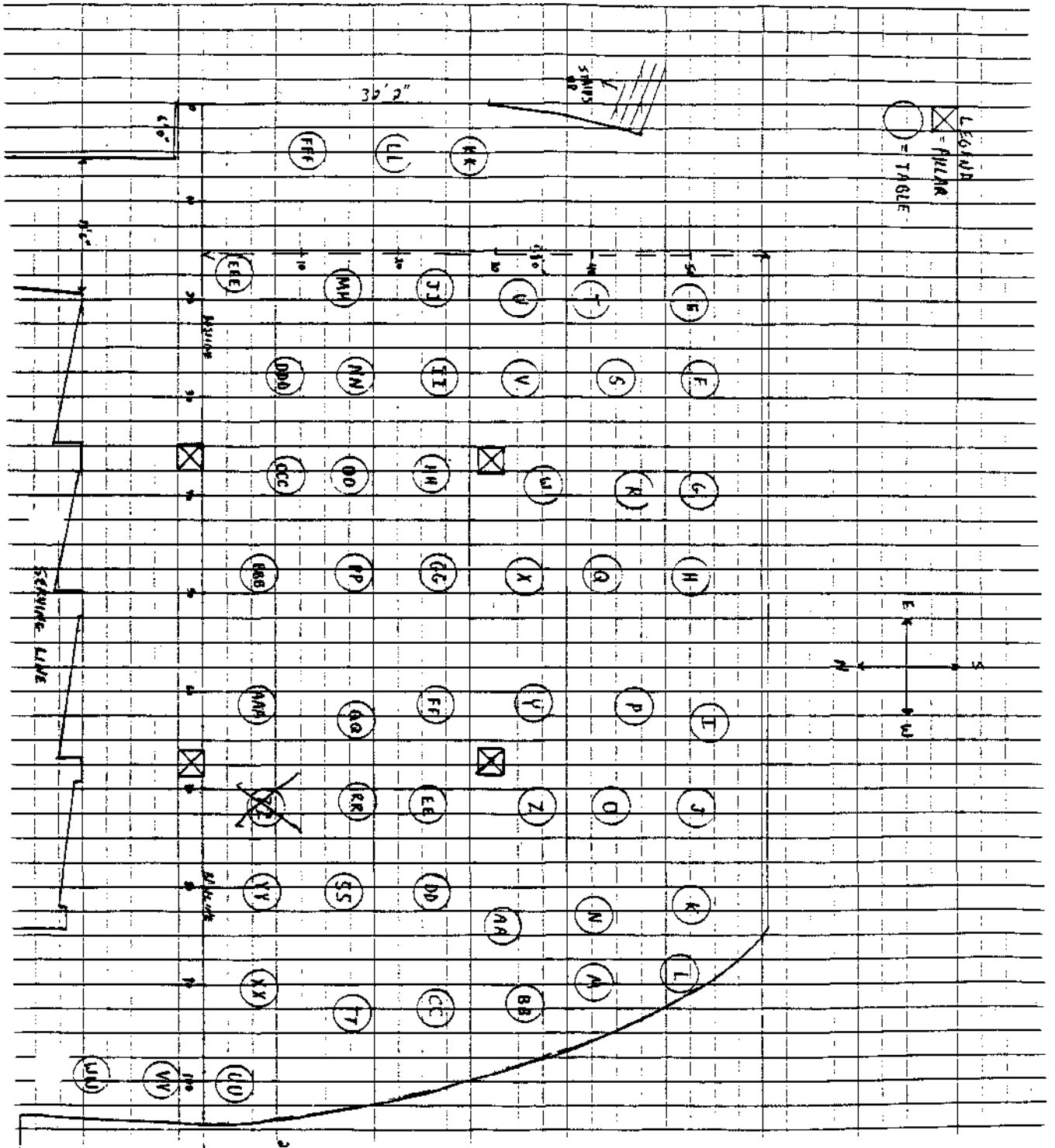

HONDA ACCORD. LIZA ENTERED THE MAIN COMMONS ENTRANCE  
FROM THE PARKING LOT AND WENT RIGHT INTO THE 'REBEL CORNER'  
STORE. HER CLASS IS THE RUNNING OF THE STORE. WORKING WITH HER  
WAS LINDSEY CRANDAL, LOUIS SCILEPPI, AND HER TEACHER MS. FROMMER  
TIVA BREMPACCHI & NICK SCHUMANN WERE IN THE BACK, COUNTING

Liza Madden was interviewed on 05-20-99 over the telephone by Inv Jill Reuteler (7394), Colorado State Patrol, at approx. 8:45 am at her residence. Ms. Madden advised that she had previously been interviewed by Det. Polak of the Denver Police Dept.

Ms. Madden said that she usually parks in space 369 in the Junior lot. She said that her car is silver 1987 Oldsmobile Cutlass Ciera 4 door with Colorado license plate GBV5925. Ms. Madden said that on 04-20-99 she attended a DECA breakfast and that she rode to school with her friend, Beth Barnes (303-979-5385). Ms. Madden said that no one parked in space 369 on 04-20-99 and that Beth parked Beth's car, a gold Honda Accord in Beth's parking space which was in the same row as Liza's space only closer to Pierce Street.

Ms. Madden said that she did not see Eric Harris' car that day, and she said that since he was a Senior, he wouldn't be parking in the Junior's parking lot.

ACTION TAKEN:

On May 5, 1999 Agent Linda R. HOLLOWAY of CBI conducted a personal interview at the residence of Columbine student Jesse MADDUX. He is a freshman this school year.

He related the events of April 20, 1999: His mother, Cheryl transported Jesse to school as she does every day. He arrived at the High School at between 7:20 and 7:25 a.m. His first class is Science Class with teacher Mr. WILL. He went straight to the classroom. After the morning classes were finished, he went to his regularly scheduled A lunch and went to the cafeteria. Since the last class before lunch got out about a minute early (11:09 a.m.) he was one of the first person in the lunch line. He got his meal and sat down at table DD. He was shown a sketch of the tables and pointed to tables SS and DD as where he remembered sitting. Other person he remembered sitting with are: Bartholomew FOSTER (a.k.a. BEAR) Justin BRYANT, Sean HOOKER and David LOCKWOOD.

Jesse was wearing jeans, a gray shirt and a white hat with the writing "Notre Dame" written on it. He is a short, heavyset child with short hair.

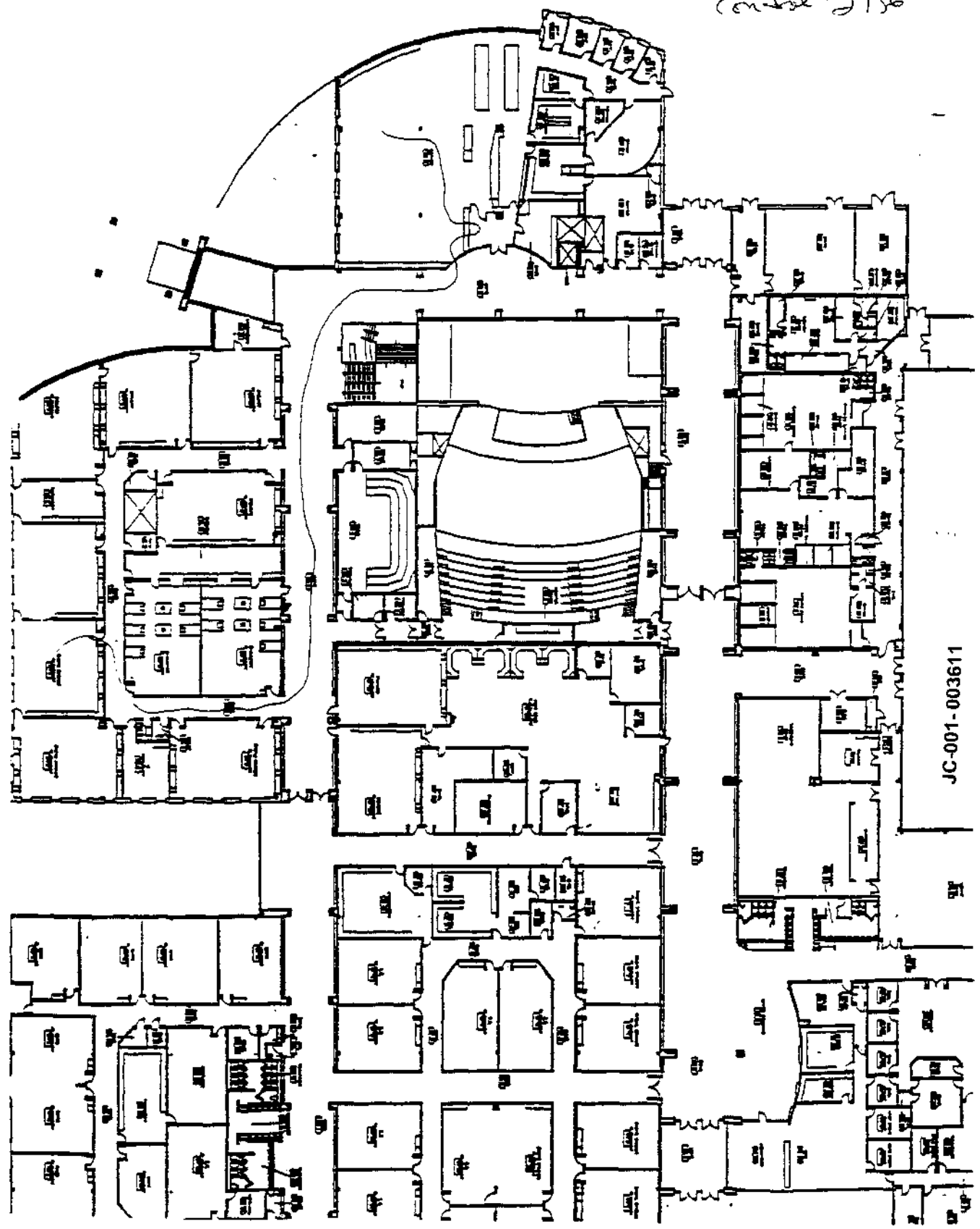
The incident that first brought attention to the incident was when a teacher yelled "get down". He got down for a short time and then heard a teacher tell them to get out. He crawled for a distance and then ran up the stairs to the first landing. He heard gunshots that he thought were coming from up the stairs.

He then ran back down the stairs and through the lower level halls where the Language Department is housed. He was in a language room for a short time and ran out one of the adjacent door to the "Seminary House" located near the school. He stayed there until about 4 p.m.

He never saw any of the gunmen or saw any of the dead or wounded students. He does not know any of the TCM, nor would he recognize them. He did not remember see the duffel bags in the cafeteria or anyone place anything suspicious in the area where he was sitting (which was close to where the devices were located).

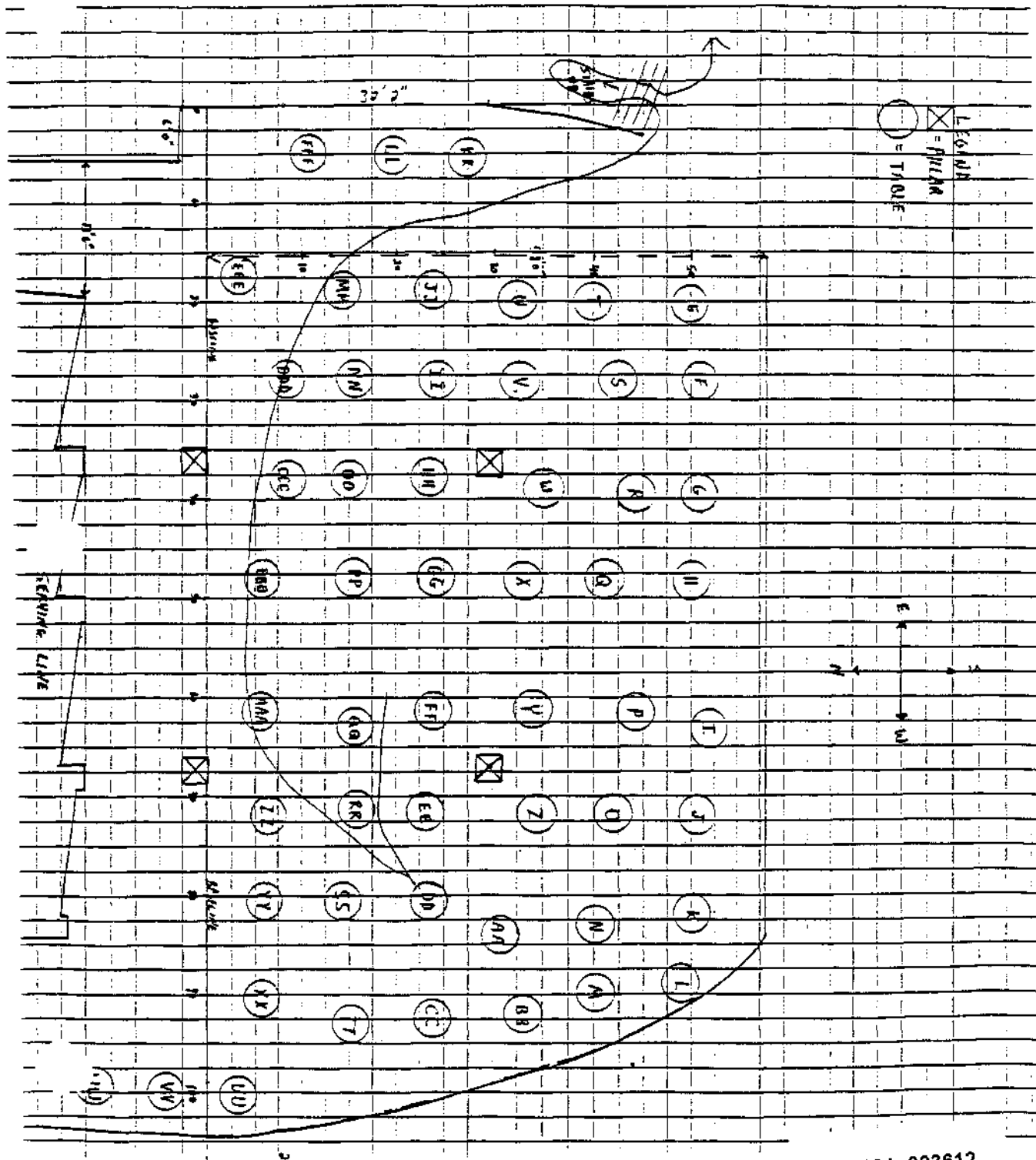

On May 1, 1999, this investigator met with Alicia Maes at her residence. Present during this interview was her mother. Alicia was shown a sketch of the cafeteria and she indicated that she had been in the area known as the "Rebel Corner" which is by the southeast doors. She advised that with her were: Crystal Archuleta, Veronica Muncio, Jennel Russell, and Aleia Russell.

Alicia stated that she arrived in the cafeteria at approximately 11:15 a.m., after her fourth hour class. She said that as she and Crystal were talking, she was looking through a window which gave her a view outside to the west. She stated that she saw a male subject trying to hold up a girl. She said it looked to her like he was standing up and the girl in his arms was on her knees. Alicia stated that she then ran out the doors closest to her and ran west to about the corner of the building. She stated that she observed a male dressed in black pants, a white shirt, wearing a black hat backwards and a black trench coat. She advised that this subject was walking down a hill. She said she saw him reach into his coat and then saw him throw an object into the parking lot. She said she heard an explosion and watched the subject walk toward the

soccer field. She stated that she then ran back into the cafeteria by way of a southwest door. She advised that she may have yelled something about a bomb as she ran back to the Rebel Corner area. She stated that many of the students were on the floor at this point. She said that she ran down the foreign language hall, east of the Rebel Corner. She said she ran out a door and continued to run to Pierce street.

Alicia stated that when she first observed the male in the black trench coat, she thought it was a person known to her as [REDACTED]. She advised that now, after seeing pictures of Dylan Klebold, she believes that this person may have been him, not [REDACTED]. She stated that she has never spoken to Eric or Dylan or [REDACTED]. She advised that her friend Crystal Archuleta had told her of seeing a tan pick-up truck circling the parking lot prior to the initial explosion.

Alicia stated that on the day of this incident, she had been wearing a dark blue shirt and blue jeans.

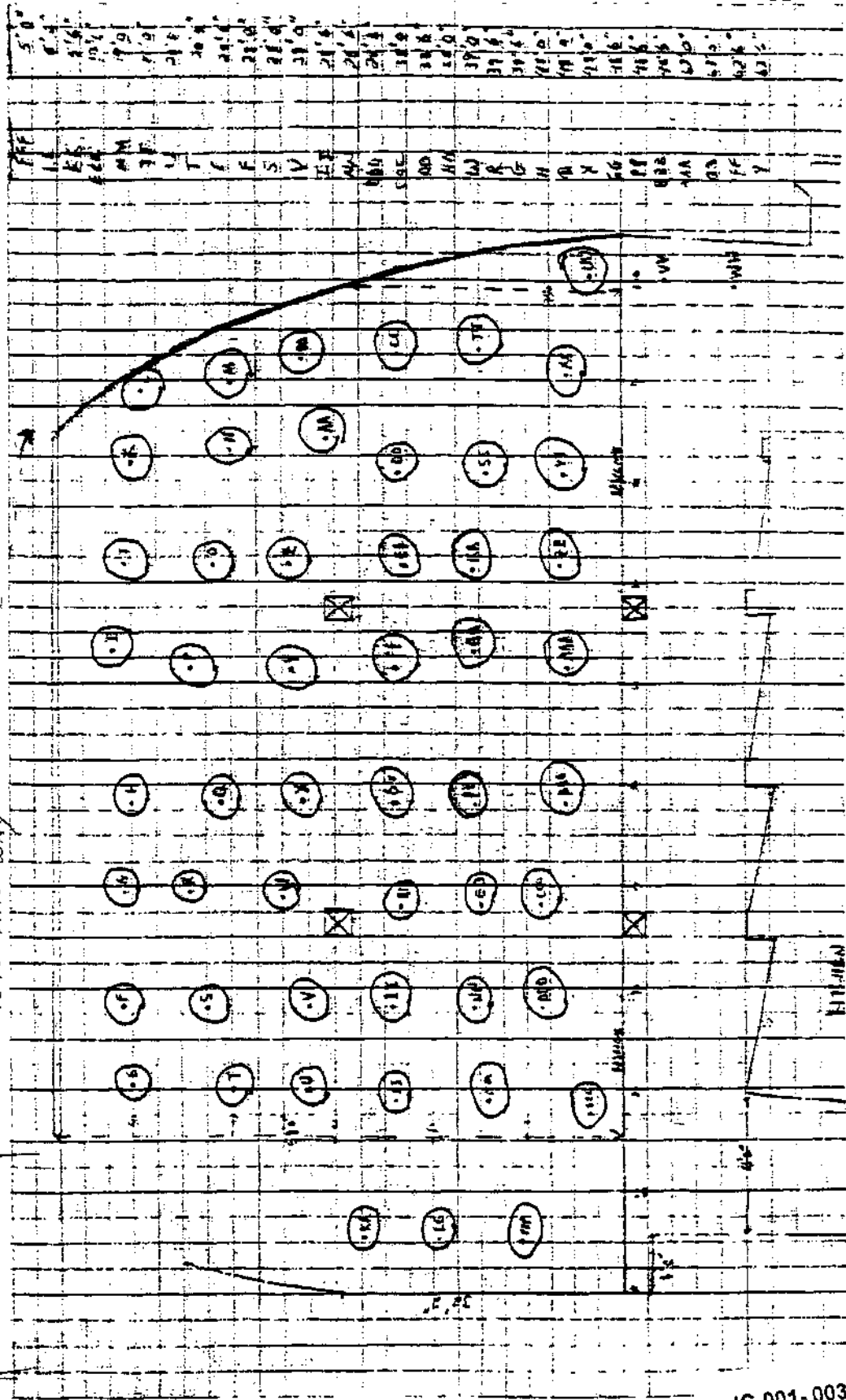

MAES began by saying she had been previously interview by an investigator from the Columbine Task Force about three weeks ago.

MAES reiterated having been by the Rebel Corner sitting with fellow classmates Crystal ARCHULETA, Janell and Aliea RUSSELL, and Veronica NUNCIO on a window ledge at about 11:20am on April 20, 1999. She describe hearing a "commotion" coming from outside so she went outside exiting through the doors by Rebel Corner with NUNCIO and ARCHULETA.

When they got outside an unidentified student told them to get down, which they did. She recalled seeing a tan colored, possibly 1980's "beat-up" compact pick-up truck driving around in the parking lot briefly, then drove from the lot turning possible right leaving the area.

She said at this point she looked to the area at the top of the exterior stairs on the west side of the cafeteria and saw a suspect whom she thought was student [REDACTED]. She clarified that this could have been Dylan Klebold, as she did not know either one of them prior to the shooting. She described this person was wearing a black trenchcoat, a black baseball style cap on backwards, black pants and black boots with possibly a white shirt. She said she saw this person walking down the grassy hill, but could not recall on which side of the stairs he was walking.

MAES said she thinks she recalls this suspect carrying a "long gun," as she thought he fired at some point toward the soccer fields. She went on to say at some point this person retrieved a pipe bomb from his coat and threw it into the student parking lot. They then turned and ran back into the cafeteria through the long row of doors when she heard an explosion from the area of the parking lot. She said they ran back to the area where they had been sitting by the window sill and laid down briefly. She described everyone in the cafeteria began running in all directions so they ran down the hallway by the foreign language classrooms and waited for about a minute. After this they exited the school where she ran toward Pierce Street where she stopped a white pick-up truck driven by an female student not known to her. This person drove her from the area.

On April 29, 1999, this investigator met with Jake Maes at his residence. Present during the interview were his parents. Jake was shown the sketch of the cafeteria and indicated that he had been at the table marked SS. He advised that others at his table included:

Matt Depew, Brian Rathbun, David Smith, Aaron Brown, Dan Palmeter and Jacob Bower.

Jake advised that he arrived in the cafeteria at approximately 11:15 a.m. after finishing his fourth hour language arts class. He said that he had been seated for about ten minutes when he heard three "pops" which he thought were firecrackers. He said that he glanced out a window west of his table and saw someone fall to the ground. He did not recognize that person but noted that he was close to the building. He advised that a teacher, probably Mr. Sanders was running outside and then came inside the cafeteria and told the students to get down. Jake said that he and the other students did get down on the floor and began crawling toward the stairs. He said

he heard someone say to get up and run and he did. He advised that he went up the stairs and then down a hallway, east out of the school building and continued to run to the park. He said that ten or fifteen minutes later, he heard what he thought were gunshots. He believed that someone was shooting in his direction so he and others ran from the park into the adjacent neighborhood.

Jake advised that on the day of this incident, he was wearing blue shorts, a gray T-shirt, and tennis shoes.

Jake stated that he did not know Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold but he did know they were "trench coat guys."

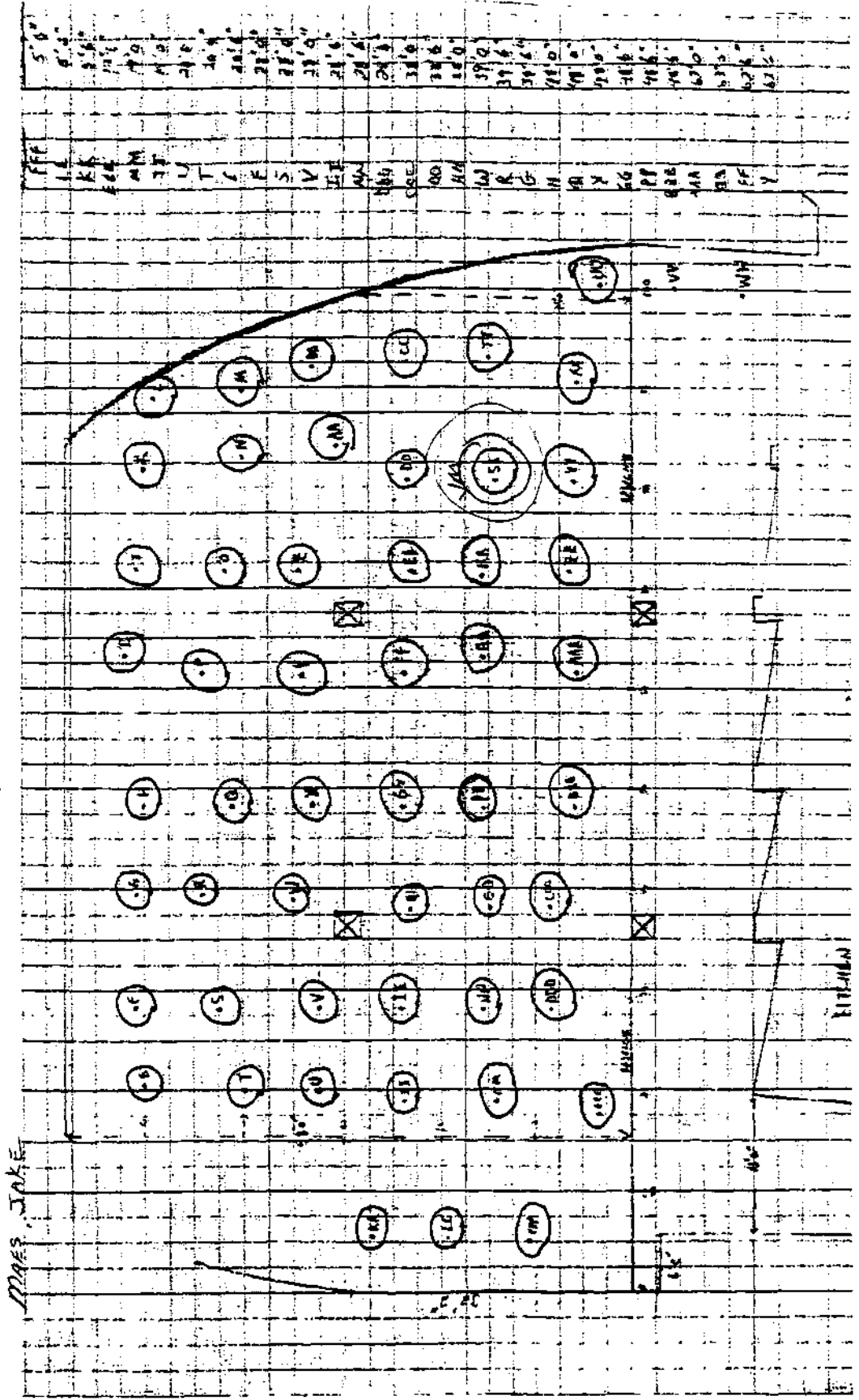

ACTION TAKEN:

On May 4, 1999 the Reporting Agent, Linda R. HOLLOWAY, called Brian MAJCEN by telephone to schedule an interview with his brother, Matthew MAJCEN. Matthew's name was on the list of student's who had possibly been in the cafeteria at the time the shootings began. Matthew informed me that his brother, Brian, is a special needs student and that a family member would need to be present to help with the interview of Brian. Matthew furthered report that he was also a student at Columbine High School and was in the school on April 20. An appointment was scheduled for the evening of May 5, 1999 for an interview with both boys at their residence in Littleton.

On May 5, 1999 at 8:30 p.m. I meet with the MAJCEN family at their home. Both parents, Tom and Gloria MAJCENE were present during the interview. Brian had another previously scheduled appointment so he was interviewed first.

He ran through the Foreign Language Hall and he and other student hid under a desk for approximately 30 minutes. He then ran out of the parking lot and over the hill to the Mormon House. He did not see any gunman or see anyone shoot.

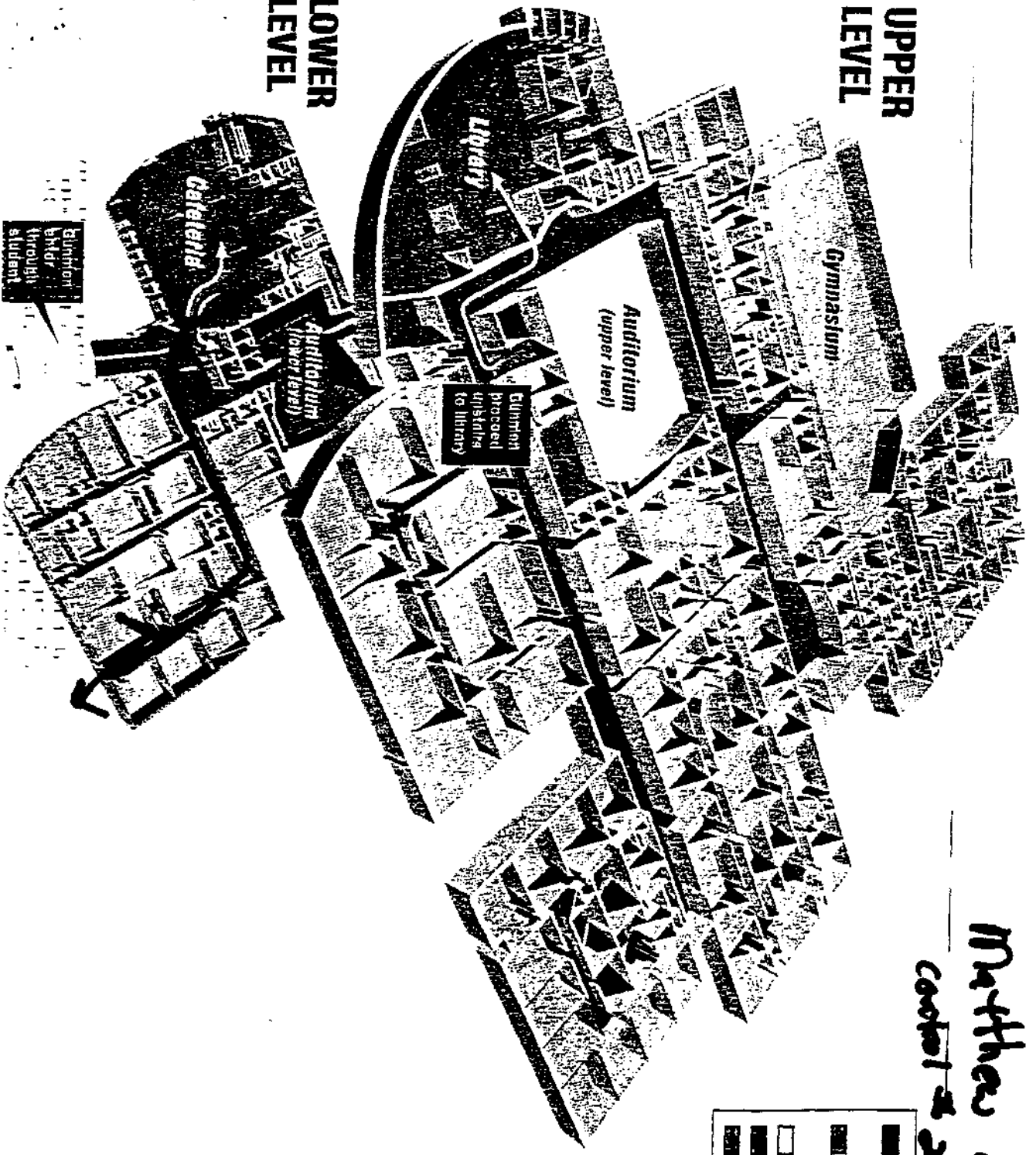

They entered through the front entrance of the school. Brandi's sister, Monica, was there for the first hour only and then left school.

Brandi stated she has choir for her first hour class, government for her second hour class, English for her third hour class, and science for her fourth hour class, all these classes are located on the top floor of the school.

After her fourth hour class, Brandi stated she saw Isaiah Shoels near her locker. She stated she invited him to come and sit at her table for lunch. He told her he had to go to the library to check out a book but would meet her in the cafeteria. Brandi stated she entered the cafeteria by coming down the stairs and was there between 1110 and 1115 hours. She stated a lot of kids were in the cafeteria already.

Brandi stated she had seen HARRIS around the school but did not know his name. She had never seen KLEBOLD before. She had heard of the "trench coat mafia" but stated that it wasn't that prevalent in the school. She knew that there was a group of TCM, however she had only seen people wearing long trench coats a couple of times. Brandi stated she did not see these people in or around the school that morning.

Brandi traced her path into the cafeteria on the attached diagram. She indicated she sat at table "V". After she put her bag on the table she bought some food from the Rebel Corner Store. After she sat down at her table, she stated she saw some kids get down on the floor who were near the west windows. At first she thought it was

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a senior prank. Then three janitors ran through the cafeteria telling everyone to get down. She stated then saw Mark Opfer run into the school through the student entrance and he had a very upset look on his face. She stated she knew something was serious then. She stated the kids on the west side of the cafeteria started to move east, some were crawling on the floor.

Brandi stated she saw a guy wearing a long black trench coat and a black ski mask inside the cafeteria. He was with another guy who was wearing a long black trench coat. The first guy had a gun inside his coat. She then saw him take something out of the coat and she then heard gunfire. She indicated where the gunmen were in the cafeteria and then where one of them moved toward table "RR".

Brandi ran up the stairs to the top floor to the area by the choir room. She stated she then ran into the auditorium from the south side. She ran through the auditorium to the top floor and ran out the north east door into the hallway. Brandi stated she saw blood on the lockers outside of this doorway. She heard gunfire and possibly some explosions. She ran east out through the front door and as she was approaching the front doors, she heard gunfire coming from behind her and the glass in the doors were shot out at that point. Once outside she ran to Clement Park and to the Jefferson Apartment complex on the north side of Bowles, and from there she called her mother who came to pick her up.

Brandi had a maroon Jansport backpack that contained her math book, Spanish book, notebooks, an agenda book, and her jeans wallet that had a Winnie-the-Pooh on it. Also in the bag was a make up bag that look similar to the wallet. Brandi was wearing a black dress with a flower design and she had on black sandals.

Brandi stated she does get on the Internet a lot. She stated a couple days after the shooting she brought up ERIC HARRIS' profile and printed on it. (See attached) She stated this was his AOL profile and she had never brought up any of his information or KLEBOLD's information before. She stated she brought HARRIS' profile up because she was curious.

Brandi remembered the thought for the day as being something to the effect of "I bet you wish you weren't here", which was in real small text.

On the morning of 04-20-99, Brandi stated that she heard a freshman by the name of Courtney remark to another unknown girl that she was going to "go get high because something big is going to happen at lunch". Brandi stated Courtney emphasized "Big" a lot. Brandi stated Courtney is a Gothic-looking girl with long black hair.



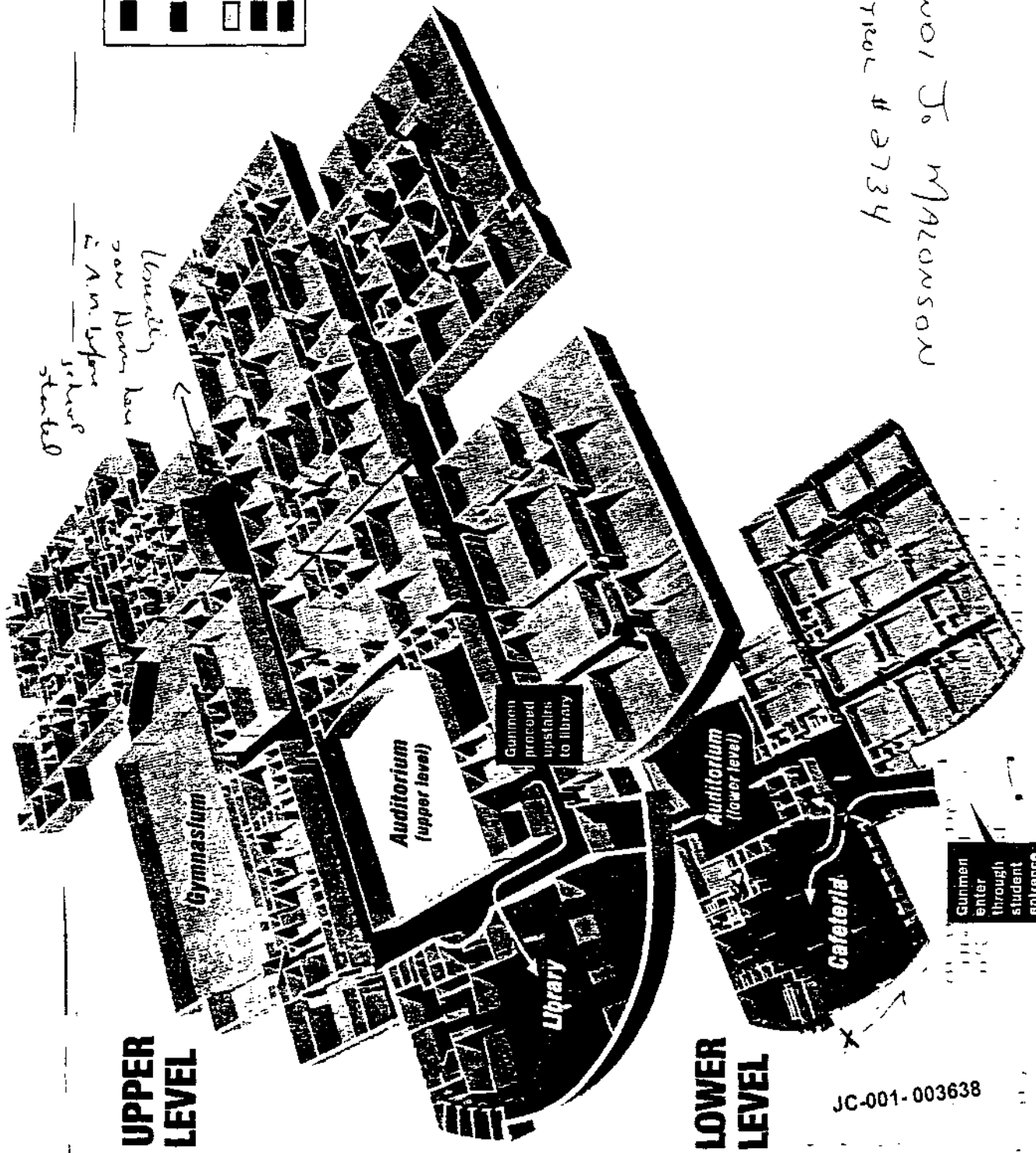

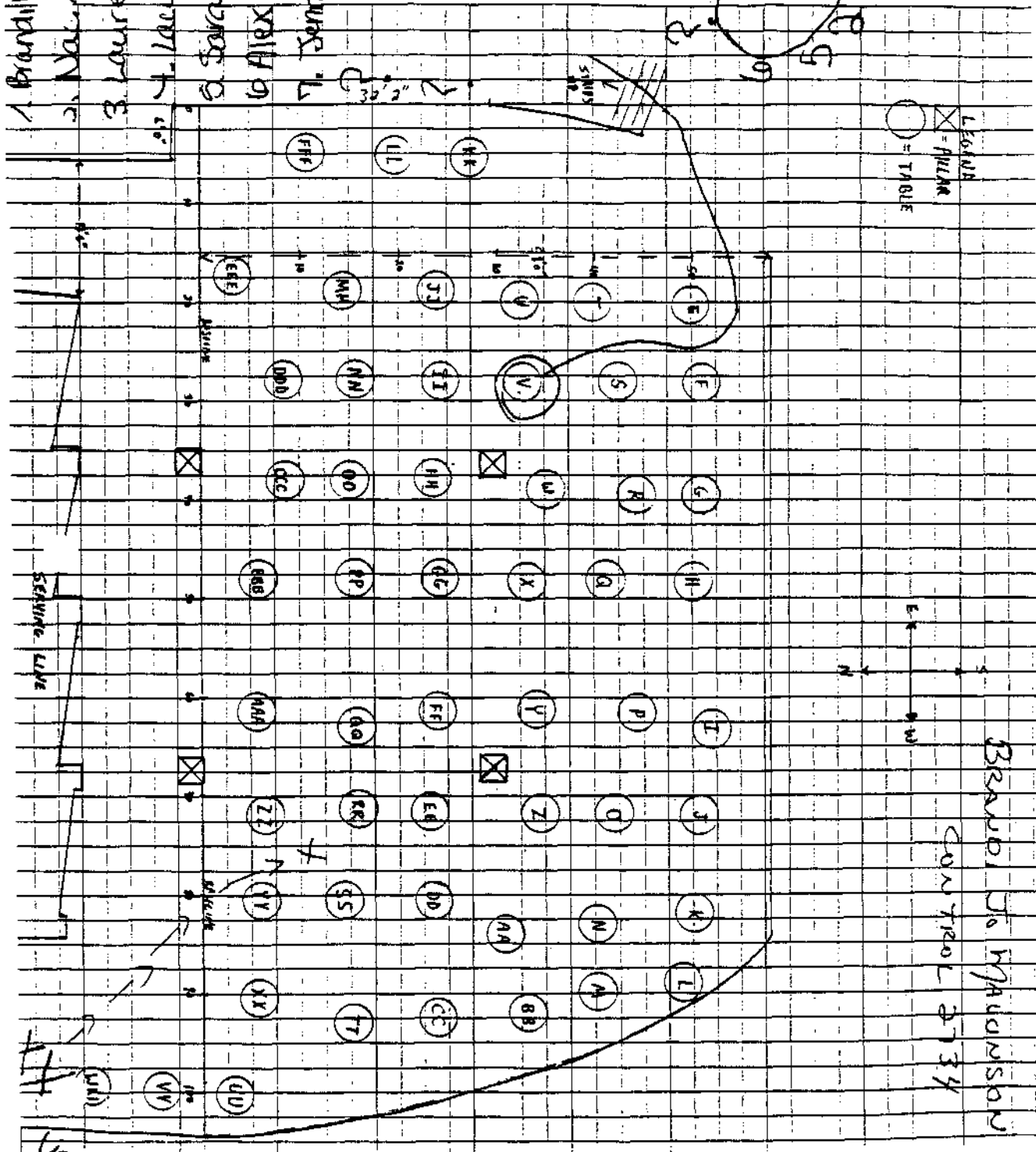

INVESTIGATION:

On May 6, 1999 at 1829 hours I contacted Valaria Mar at her home for an interview. Her mother was present. While at the home, I also interviewed Valaria's twin brother, Arty, who was in a science room during the incident until rescued by SWAT. Valaria then told me the following:

- \* She is a freshman at Columbine High School.
- \* When asked about Eric Harris, she said that she does not know him by face or name. She may have seen him in a trench coat once or twice in school, but she was not sure.

\* When asked about Dylan Klebold, she said that she does not know him by face or name.

\* When asked, she did not know [REDACTED]

\* She did not know any other trench coat students or associates. She has only seen the one student once or twice in school this year.

\* She has never heard of the name "Trench Coat Mafia."

\* She did not see any suspicious objects in school that day. When asked specifically, she did not see any duffle bags.

\* On the day of the shooting, she had a 4th hour ceramics class in the art area of the school. She stayed a few minutes late in that class to help clean up. At about 11:15 a.m. she walked down to the library with Margot Brown. Margot was going to spend the lunch time in the library.

\* She then walked down to a table in the cafeteria and dropped her backpack off on a chair to reserve her spot. She did not know who else may have been at that table as she and her friends usually sit at three tables that are grouped together. She looked at the diagram and said she dropped her pack off at table KK. This was the location her pack was recovered from. She and her friends sit at KK, LL, and FFF.

\* After she dropped her pack off, she went to Rebel Corner to get a meal. She was joined by Margot Brown who decided not to spend the lunch hour in the library.

\* While in the line to get her food, she saw several students going out the south doors. A few minutes later she saw the students come back in. She then saw everyone in the cafeteria getting down under the tables. She then moved over to one of the tables by Rebel Corner and got under it. She then followed a group out of the

cafeteria that went down to the foreign language area. She wound up in a Spanish class that is in the far southeast corner of that area. She went under a desk for about 5 minutes. She heard 3 or 4 gunshots or explosions. Two unknown teachers then had them run out the south exit door by that classroom and through the lot to a Mormon house on Polk Street. She said that she stayed in the garage to that home. She did not hear anything else.

\* She did not see any suspects.

\* She was wearing jeans, a cream colored vest, and black sandals on the day of the shooting.

\* She added that a girl who sits in front of her in her 1st hour geometry class told her on the morning of the shooting that a lot of people were going to get "high" that day. She said the girl said it was "4-20 day." There was also a mention about police. (This is consistent with information about "4-20" being the code and a date for marijuana smokers.) She thought the name of this girl was Michelle.

This concluded my interview with Valaria Mar.

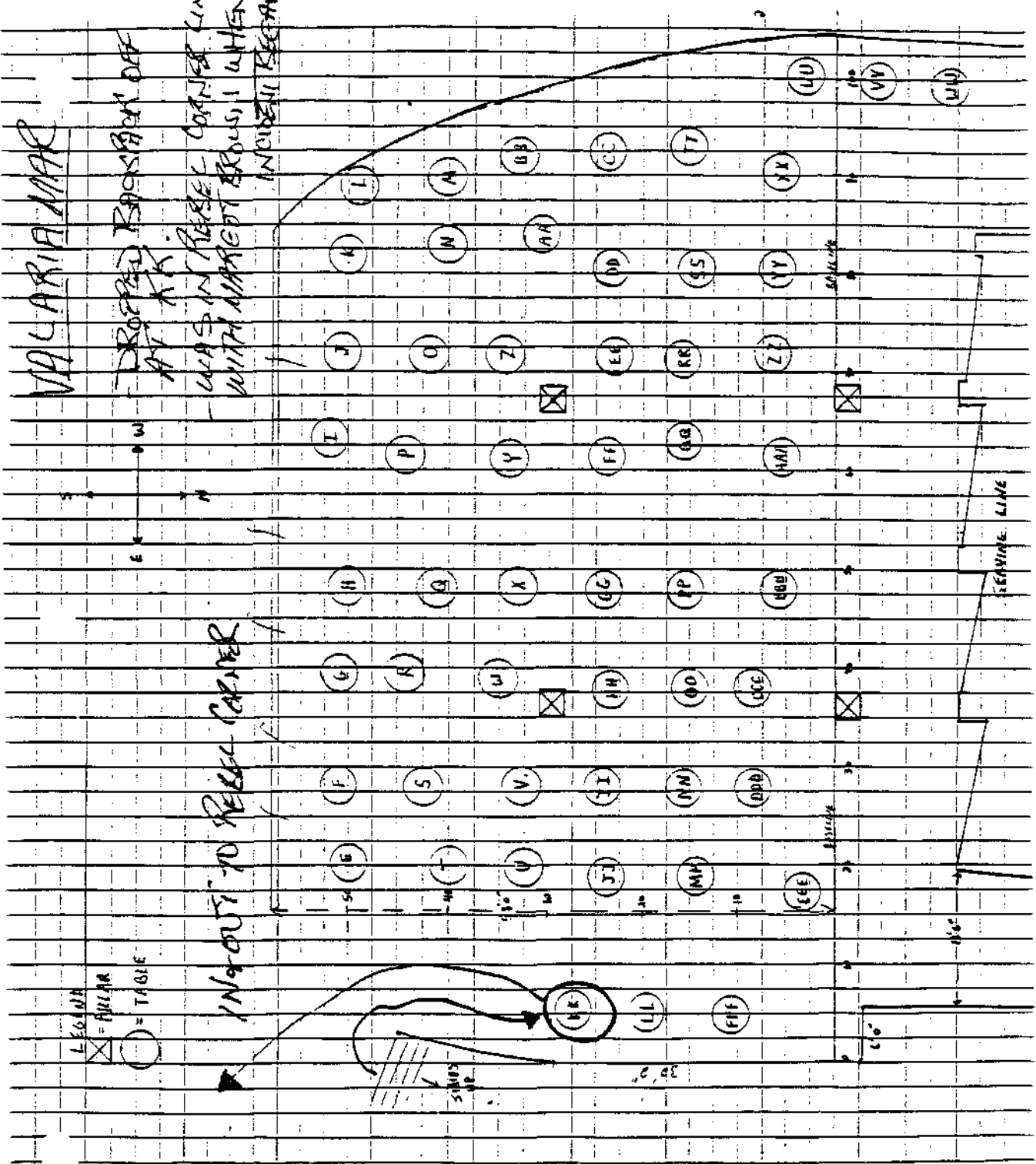

**OBSERVATION/INVESTIGATION:**

On 051499 Sgt. Webb and myself contacted Joey Marcotte at Chatfield High School, where I told her I needed to speak to her about some information regarding the shooting incident. Joey stated that she had no problem talking to us. I told Joey that I needed to ask her questions about her description of one of the shooters. Joey stated that she had seen the suspect come into the cafeteria wearing a black baseball hat, but she couldn't see his face very clear because it was covered up, but he was wearing an orange or white T-shirt with some kind of writing on it, then he had a trench coat on, with some kind of automatic weapon. I asked Joey if she saw his hair, and she stated that she remembers that he had long curly black hair. I asked Joey if she could describe his pants and she stated that they were "real baggy" black jeans. I asked if the pants were some other type of material or jean material, Joey was certain they were jean material. I then asked Joey where she was when she saw this individual, and she stated that she was down on one knee (which she demonstrated), under table "E", Joey stated that she was under the table about an hour and a half, and that she heard a lot of angry yelling and cussing from someone with a "deep dark mean and scary voice". I asked Joey if she could tell me what they said, and she stated that the voice stated "Today is the day the world comes to an end, today is the day we die". I asked Joey what else she remembered and she stated that she heard lots of explosions, and gunfire, and that the smoke started getting thick in the cafeteria, that's when she started crawling to the door to get out. I asked Joey which door she went out, and she stated that she went out by the "Rebel Store" doors, then she ran out into the parking lot and hid by some cars on the south side by a "big" fence at the last row to the west in the Senior lot. Joey stated that she was hiding next to a tan colored car. Members of a SWAT Team rescued her.

I asked Joey if she had seen anyone else, and she stated that she had. I asked her to describe that suspect for me. Joey stated that he was wearing a blue baseball cap, and that he had blonde hair. The suspect was wearing a white T-shirt with some kind of ammunition vest that was black, and he had regular blue jeans on. I asked her if there was anything else she could remember about him and she stated that his T-shirt was splattered with blood. I asked Joey who she thought that was, and she stated that she thought it was Dylan.

I asked Joey what time she first saw these guys, and she stated that she believed it was 11:20 AM. That was when she first saw "Eric" run by the window of the cafeteria, headed toward the stairs. He put down a black duffel bag with 2 handles, she remembers him having on a trench coat and seeing pipe bombs and shotgun shells hanging on his chest, and he had a small handgun in his hand. Joey went on to say that all this had occurred before the sprinklers went off, and during that time both of them were shooting when they

Christopher Shan Markham, DOB 02/06/1984, 7156 South Pierce Court, Littleton, Colorado, telephone (303)904-3538, a freshman at Columbine High School, was interviewed at his home in the presence of his mother, Sherry Markham, by Special Agent (SA) Ricky V. Wright regarding the incident that took place on 04/20/1999 at Columbine High School. After being advised as to the identity of the interviewing agent and the nature of the interview, Markham provided the following information:

At approximately 11:10 am, Markham got out of French class and left the foreign language department and went directly to the cafeteria. Markham set his bookbag down at a lunchroom table (marked SS on diagram sketch), got his lunch, and sat back down. Markham remembers that Tim Mulcahey, Bear Foster, Nate Vauderau, Jon Fries, Patrick Caruso, Erik Sunde, and Jesse Maddox were also sitting at his table. Markham was sitting facing northeast. Markham thinks that Vauderau was sitting to his right. Markham does not recall who was sitting to his left.

Markham was eating his lunch, when he heard what sounded like shots and an explosion outside the cafeteria to the northwest. Markham stood up and ran to the cafeteria door by the teachers' lounge and opened the door and looked outside. Markham saw Lance Kirklin, Dan Rohrbough, and Sean Graves all lying just outside the cafeteria door. Sean Graves was the closest and said that he had been shot. Matt Katzenmeier was also at the door looking out. Mr. Sanders, another teacher, and a janitor helped pull Graves inside the cafeteria. Markham turned and ran down the west side of the cafeteria and began yelling that someone was shooting. Markham huddled down in the northeast corner of the cafeteria for a moment and then started to crawl toward the stairs. By this time, most of the students in the cafeteria were also huddled down. Markham had been carrying a sandwich in his hand and paused to throw it in the trash can at the foot of the stairs. Markham then jumped the rail to the stairs and ran up the stairs to the choir room next to the stairs and pounded on the door. The choir teacher, Mr. Andres, came out and Markham told him what was going on. Markham then tried to knock on a door on the south side of the main hall, but no one came. Markham then ran east down the main hall and then north down the language and history hall toward the school offices. Stephanie

Lohrenz and Katie Beer were also in the hall and ran toward the school offices as well. While they were running, they heard five or six shots coming from the direction of the school offices. Markham did not see anyone, but they turned around and ran back to the south main hall and then east out the exit at the end of the hall. Once outside Markham jumped over a fence and ran across Pierce Street to Leawood Park.

Markham was in the cafeteria for about 20 minutes at the end of first hour. Markham was sitting in the vicinity of the table marked YY on the diagram sketch with Tim Mulcahey, Brenda Kelly, and Kacey Fisher. Markham did not see the gunmen during the shooting. Markham did not remember seeing any large duffle bags sitting in the cafeteria during lunch or first period. Markham knew Eric Harris and Dylan Klebold, because they would come over to Markham's residence with Chris Morris, who was the boyfriend of Markham's sister, Nicole Markham. Markham has known Harris and Klebold since December 1998. Markham estimates that they came over approximately 20 times. Sometimes they would play Nintendo or play Monopoly. Markham would sometimes go to midnight bowling at a bowling alley located at Belleview and Federal with Harris, Klebold, Nicole Markham, Chris Morris, Krista Hanley, Robyn Anderson, and Tiffany Last Name Unknown (LNU). Markham never knew Harris or Klebold to talk about guns or bombs. Markham does not have an Internet screen name.

On the day of the shooting, Markham was wearing a green t-shirt, blue jeans, and brown shoes.

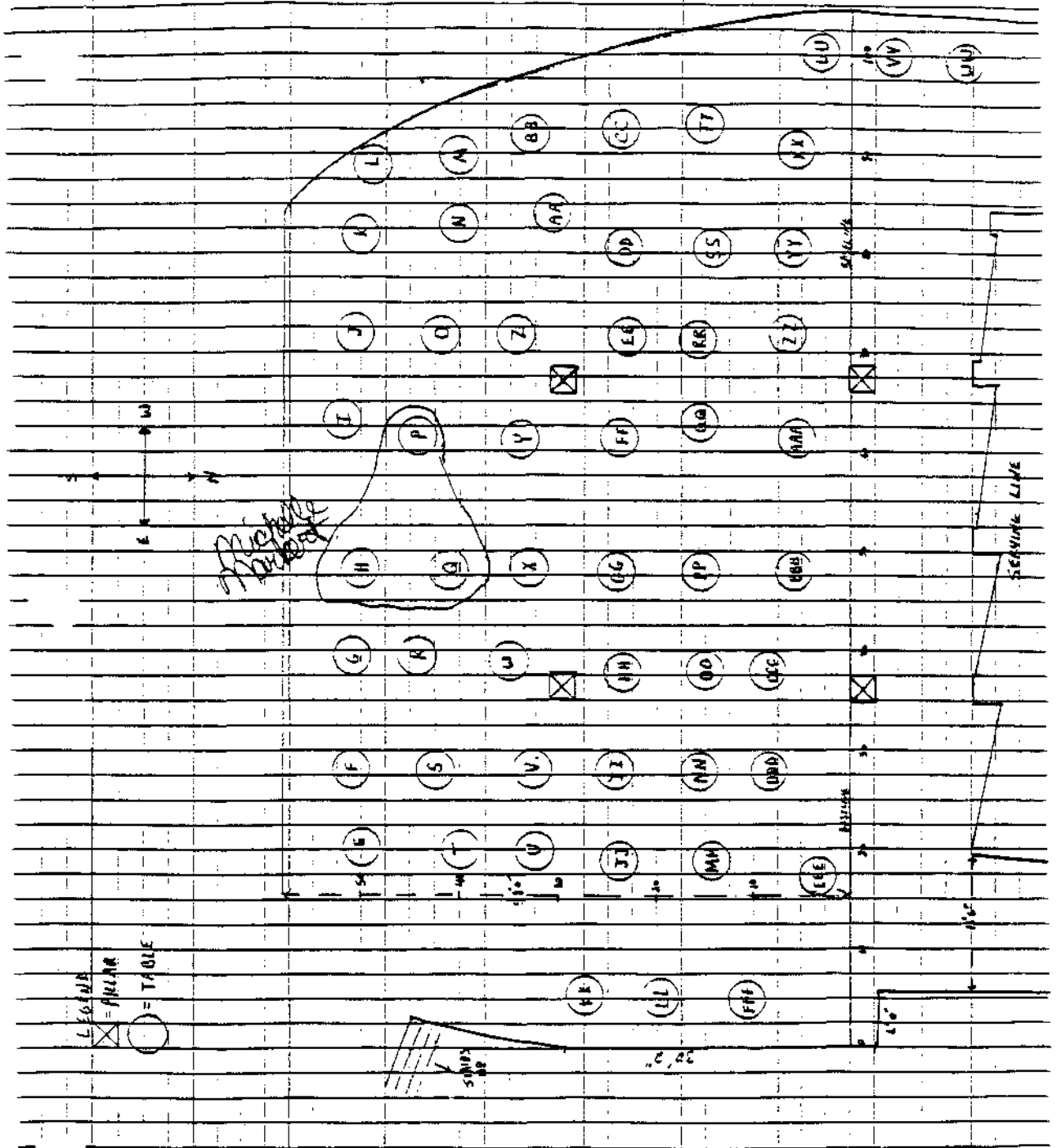

Chandra stated she had seen KLEBOLD and HARRIS around the school but did not know their names. She was aware of the "trench coat mafia" who were identified by the long, black coats. She stated they were just like any other clique at the school, they liked to hang around together. She stated she had classes with some of the girls in the group but she did not know their names. She stated she did not see any of the group that day. She stated she saw the group more last year than she has this year.

After her interview on the second floor, she went to the financial office briefly with her friend, Noel Snyder. Chandra and Noel then returned to the cafeteria by going down the stairs entering at approximately 1105 hours.

She stated at 1110 hours, the bell ran and Noel left. Chandra stated she sat at the same table with different people this time. These people are indicated on the attached diagram.

Chandra bought her lunch from the serving line and then sat back down at the table. She stated she was at the far west serving line and she did not notice any large duffle bags when she walked through the cafeteria. She stated ten to fifteen minutes later the commotion began. Mr. Sanders and a janitor ran around the cafeteria telling everyone to get under the tables. She stated it was very noisy in the cafeteria and she thought that it was a prank, so the people at her table began to joke around about it. She stated people started to get up when Mr. Sanders yelled at them to get down again. She stated Mark, who she was sitting with, suddenly got up and took his backpack and started for the stairs. She stated then people started to stand up and leave the west side of the cafeteria and it appeared to be like a wave of people leaving. She stated she went up the stairs with everyone.

Chandra stated that she heard three gunshots when she neared the choir room. She stated this was the first time that she heard any gunshots or explosions. She stated she ran out the south east door and across Pierce to the park. At that time she heard explosions along with gunfire and screaming. She stated at that point she didn't know what was going on. She stated a group of kids left with her and went to Brett O'Neal's home on Kendall Street.

Chandra stated that she had a blue Eastpack backpack with her purse inside and a green plastic multi folder. Chandra stated she was wearing a long-sleeved white swim team shirt with jean shorts and tennis shoes.

Chandra stated she couldn't remember what the thought for the day was but she remembered that it didn't have anything to do with the shooting.

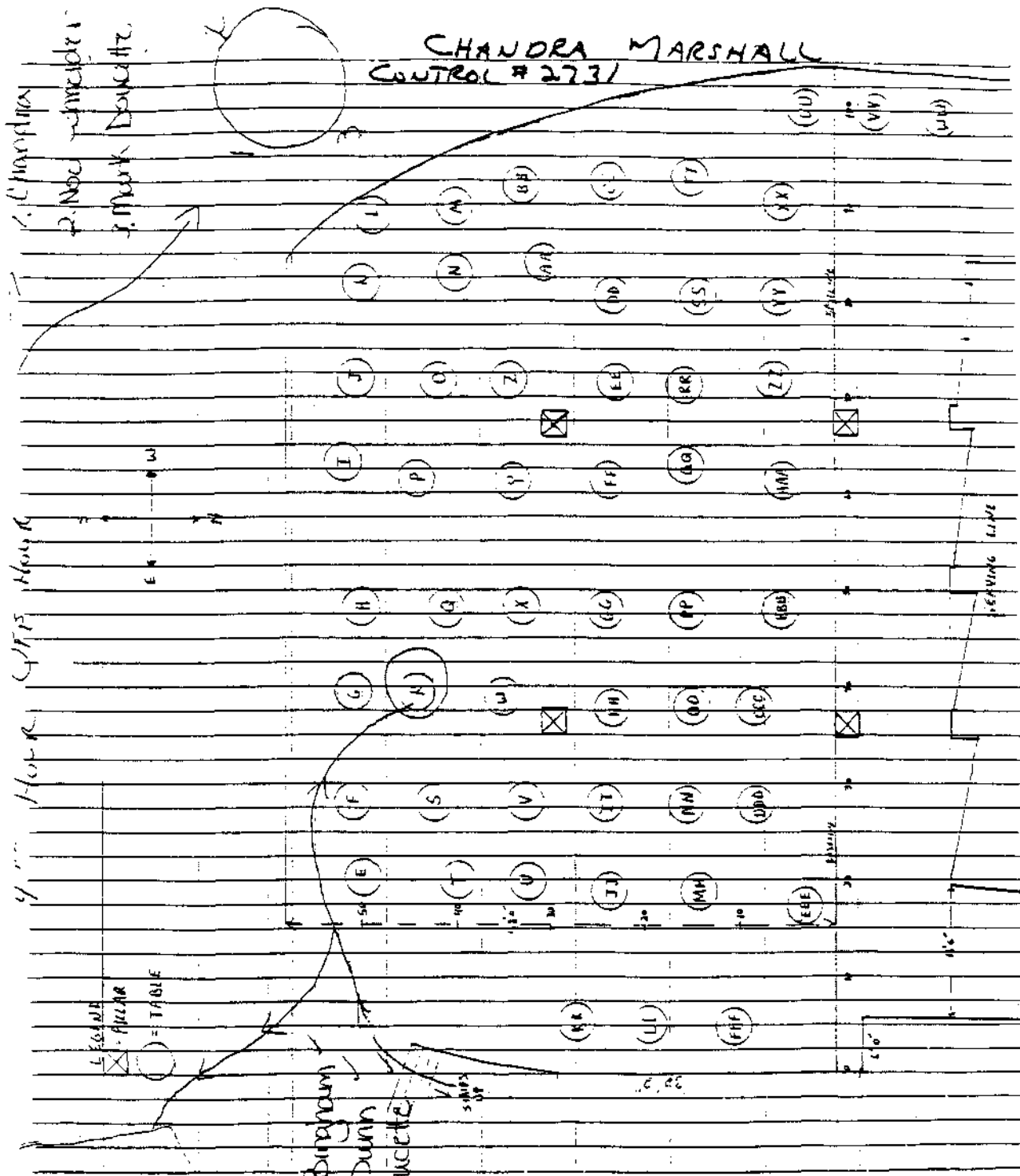

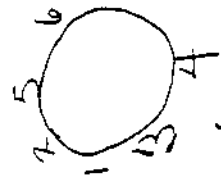

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Martin stated that on 4/20/99 her mother drove her to school and that she arrived at the school at approximately 0725 hours. She said that her mother had driven her and her two sisters, Jennifer and Stephanie, to school and dropped them off at the main entrance. She said that she then went to her locker to pick up several notebooks and went to her first hour class in the Science wing upstairs. After her first hour class she went to her locker and then her second hour class which is American Studies, which is upstairs in the language department. After her second hour class she went to her History class, her third hour, which is also located in the same room. She said that between second and third hour she went to her locker. She said from third hour she went to her fourth hour Spanish class which is located in the lower level. She then went to the "A" lunch. She said she's actually scheduled for the "A" and "B" lunch together. She said that she had her pack with her and that she went to table number "Z", as she looked at the cafeteria map. She said there were already students at the table, and identified those students as Stephanie Wise, Carmie Deihl, Nicole Janda, and three other unknown named females. She said that she went to the food service line and purchased a taco salad, went back to the table and began to make the salad, and began to eat which she believed to be about 11:25. Mr. Sanders came running into the cafeteria from near the faculty room, yelling "Get down! Get down!" She said that at first she didn't get under the table and remained seated; then she noticed that people were under the table and that something appeared to be wrong. She said she then heard something that sounded like firecrackers and she began to crawl away from the windows. As she was crawling, she noticed everyone got up and that people were starting to run towards the stairwell to exit the cafeteria. She said that she got up and started walking toward the stairs. She said that she waited for a large wave of students to pass and then she started to go up the stairs when she heard what she thought was a gunshot and saw smoke at the top of the stairwell. She described the smoke as being grey in color and appeared to be a small isolated cloud. She thought it might have been from a gunshot burst. She then turned back down the stairs, and said that there were several teachers telling the students to go down the foreign language hallway. She said that she ran down the hallway, turned right, and ended up in classroom F-3. She said there were numerous other students in the classroom and that they huddled against the wall and closed the blinds. She said that the teachers in the room could hear more gunshots, and that there were people trying to

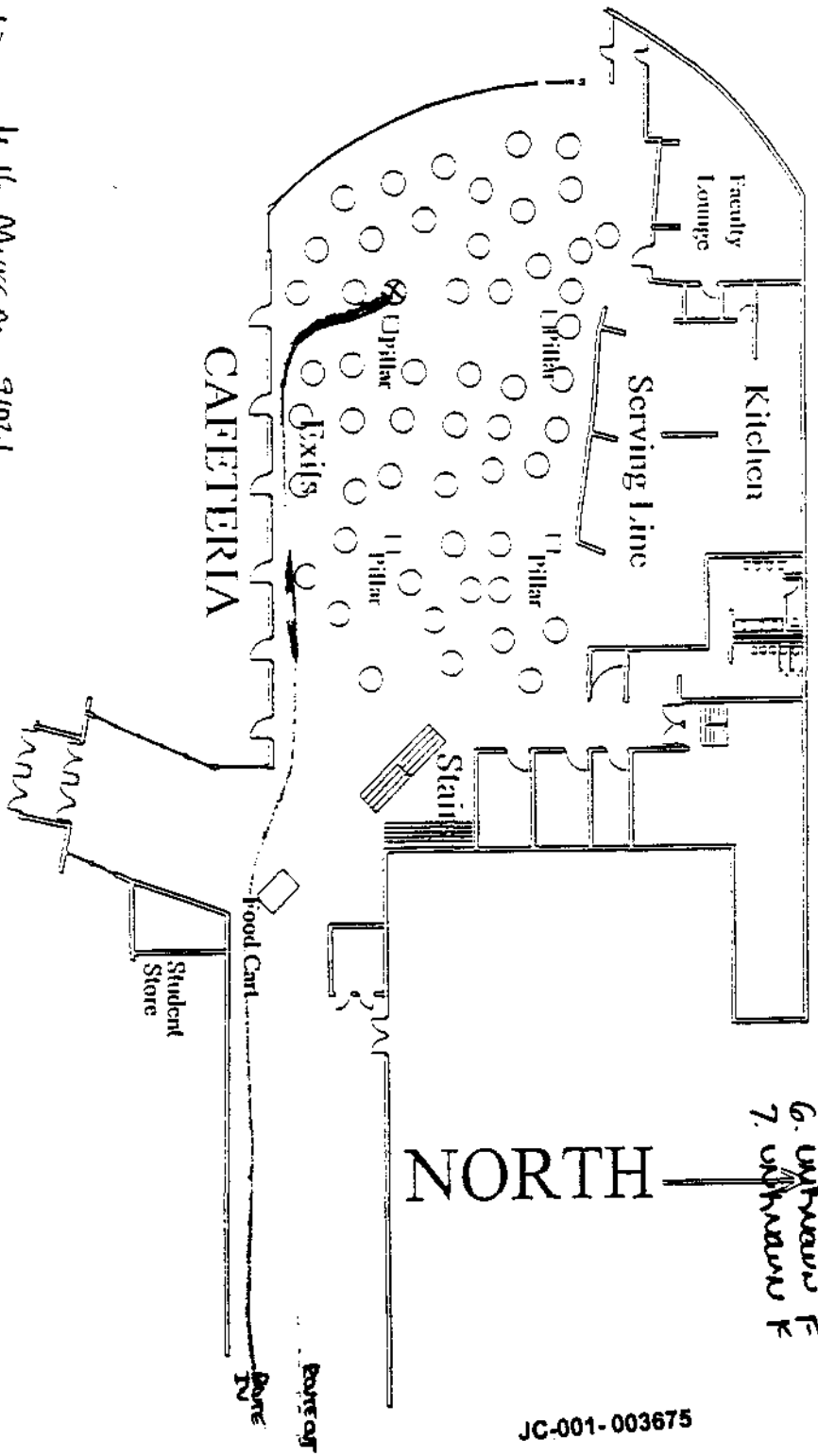
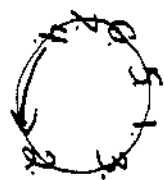

at Columbine High School. This interview was in reference to the shooting that occurred on 4-20-99 at Columbine High School

I interviewed Robert Massie in the presence of his grandmother, Pat Massie. Robert Massie told me on 4-20-99, at approximately 1110 hours, he got out of his math class, which is in the math hall on the second level at Columbine High School. Robert said he proceeded to go downstairs by himself and entered the cafeteria at approximately 1115. Robert said that he saw several friends of his that were in the cafeteria at a table so he joined the friends at this table. Robert said these friends were Lance Kirklin, Anthony Sammanro, Sean Graves, Steven Curnow, and Daniel Rohrbouge. I showed Robert Massie a diagram of the Columbine High School cafeteria and he told me that the table he was sitting at on 4-20-99 was table "YY". This table is located on the far west side of the cafeteria and just south of the faculty lounge. This table is also due east of the door from the exterior of the Columbine High School cafeteria to the interior by the faculty lounge.

Robert Massie said that after talking for a few minutes at the table Lance Kirklin, Sean Graves, Robert Rohrbouge, and Steve Curnow got up from the table and exited the cafeteria through the far west door near the faculty lounge. Robert said these friends went outside the door and then began to go up the stairs. Robert said that he heard several noises that he believed were fireworks going off, however, he did not know how many of these noises he heard. Robert said that when he looked outside of the cafeteria towards the parking lot he saw smoke near a vehicle that was parked in the lot. Robert said then he heard approximately 10 to 15 more noises that were apparently gunshots. Robert said a student came running into the cafeteria through the far west door by the faculty lounge, and said that there had been shots fired outside. Robert said at this point several teachers entered the cafeteria and told all the students to get up and run out of the cafeteria and upstairs to the second level of Columbine High School. Robert said when he began running, he said it took approximately five minutes to get from his table to the second level of the high school due to the fact all the students were trying to run at the same time and were running into each other and knocking each other down in the cafeteria. He said when he got to the top of the stairs, he went towards the science hall where he saw a teacher waving students into a classroom at that location. Robert said he ran into a science class and it was the science class where Mr. Sanders was. Robert said once inside of this classroom, someone locked the door between the classroom and the hallway and he said all the lights were turned off. The students sat up against the wall so that if one of the suspects looked through the window in the door, they would be unable to see anyone inside. Robert said the students did take the tables that were in this classroom and lay them on their sides to hide them further while in the classroom. Robert said that there were two classrooms

which had students hiding in this manner, and said there is a door between the classrooms. He also said while he was sitting in the dark against the wall he heard "real loud booms" and believed they were bombs going off. He said it sounded as if these explosions were coming from directly below the science classroom on the first level and said when one of the bombs went off everything in the science room shook. Robert said he believed he heard four to five of these bombs detonated in the school. Robert said that while waiting in the classroom, one of the teachers was watching a television set so they could follow the events taking place at Columbine High School through the media. Robert said at approximately 1530 to 1545 hours, all the students he was hiding with in the science classroom were rescued by SWAT, and then taken from the school to Leawood Elementary School. Robert said at Leawood Elementary School he met with his mother, his father, and his step-father at that location.

I asked Robert Massie if he knew either one of the suspects prior to this incident. Robert said that he had Eric Harris in his gym class during the first semester of 1999. Robert said that Eric Harris would stay to himself and when he came to and left the gym class he always wore black clothing. Robert said Eric Harris wore a black trench coat in the school and said that he did not believe this trench coat was made out of leather, saying it was probably made from cloth. Robert Massie said he never talked to Eric Harris or associated with him. Robert Massie said Eric Harris worked at Columbine High School in the Rebel News Network (RNN). I asked Robert Massie if he knew what the "thought of the day" was at Columbine High School on 4-20-99. He said that at the time that the "thought of the day" is broadcasted in the morning, he was in his gym class and therefore did not know what the "thought of the day" was on 4-20-99. Robert Massie said that he did not know who Dylan Klebold was prior to this incident, and does not recall seeing him before, other than photographs in the media since the shooting.

I showed Robert Massie a photograph of the duffle bag and the propane tank that was later recovered in the cafeteria of Columbine High School. Robert said that he does not remember seeing either item, either prior to or during incident on 4-20-99.

I asked Robert Massie how he has been coping with the incident since the shooting on 4-20-99, and he said he had some problems, however, he feels he is doing fairly well dealing with the incident. I asked his grandmother, Pat Massie, and she said she agreed that he was doing fairly well, however, in the beginning, after the shooting, for about the first one to two weeks, Robert was having some problems dealing with the incident. I gave both Pat Massie and Robert Massie my business card and asked them to contact me if they wanted to talk with a JCSO Victim Advocate in the future. I advised I would make the necessary

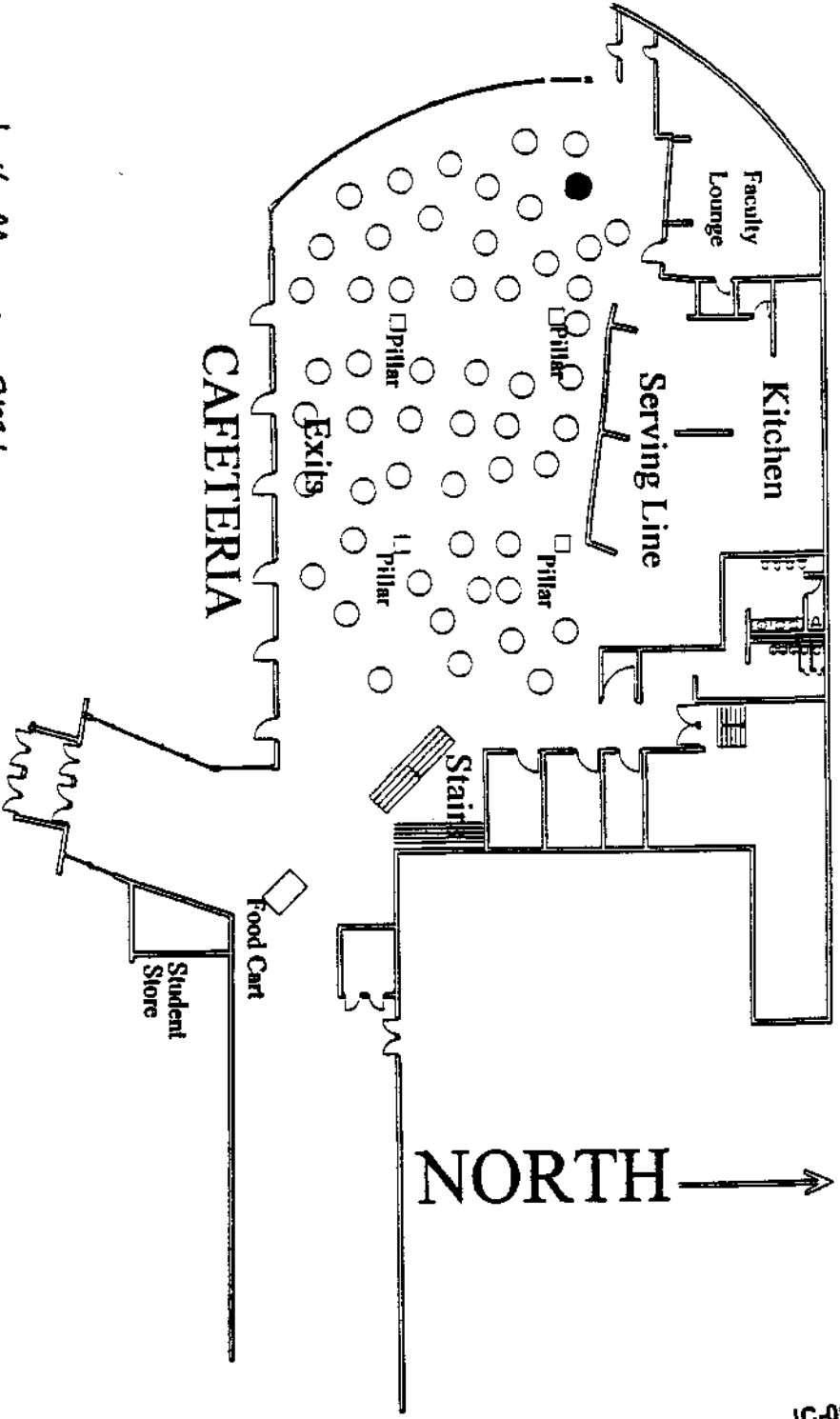

Since the shooting, Robert has since changed residences and is now living with his father, Bob Massie, and grandparents at 5065 Umatilla Street. Robert and Pat Massie said this was due to family problems and not due to the shooting that occurred at Columbine High School on 4-20-99. Pat Massie said that as far as she knows Robert has not decided yet whether he will return to Columbine High School in the fall of 1999 or go to Ranum High School in Adams County. Apparently the decision is going to be based on the family situation at the time.

**DISPOSITION:** Case remains open, pending further investigation.

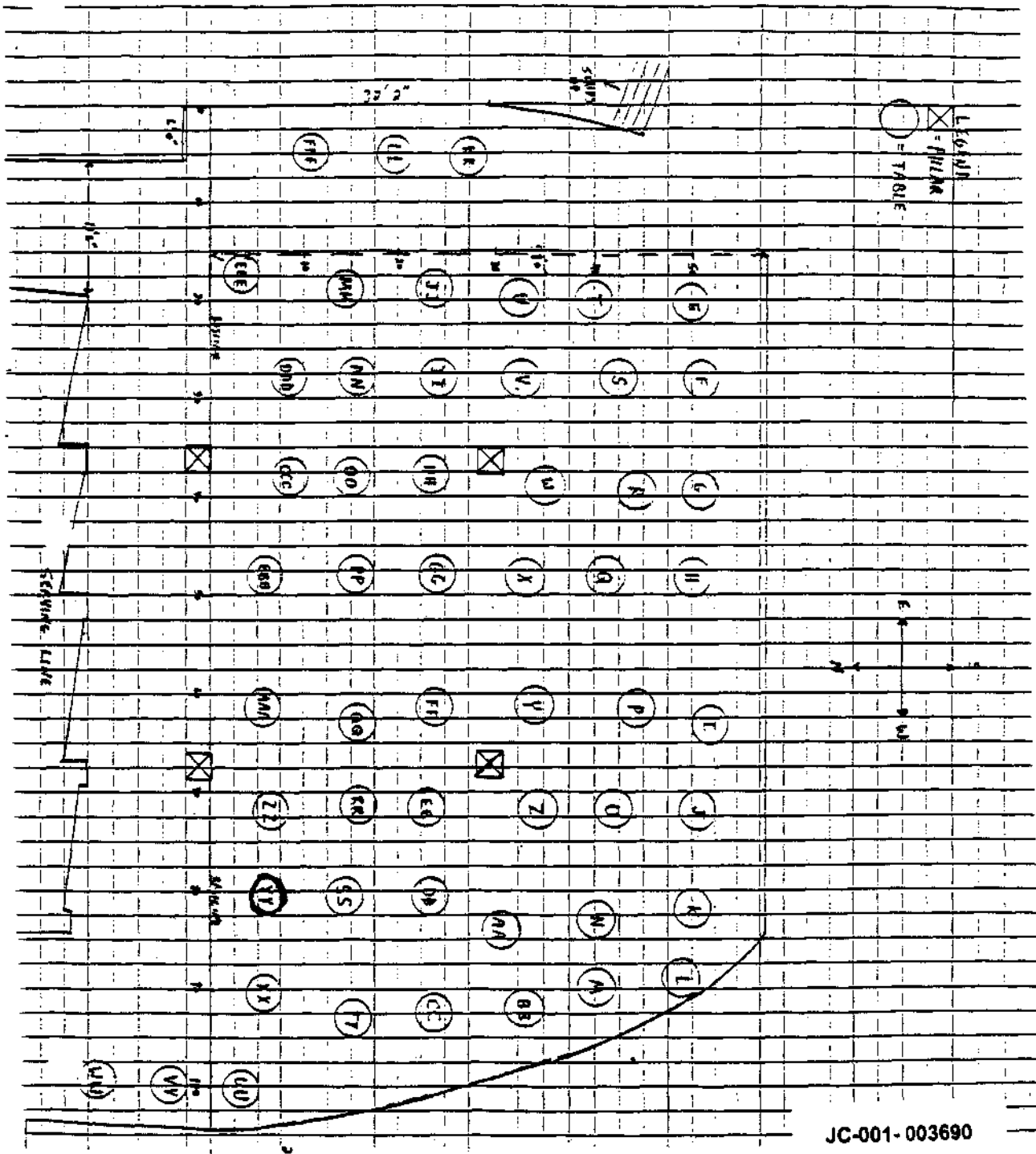

at one of those tables by the student store which are not on the diagram. He was in the cafeteria from around 8:45 to about 8:50. He didn't see anything at that time that didn't seem to belong in the cafeteria. He saw no one wandering around that didn't seem to belong there.

Tim said that 4th hour is his off hour. He went to lunch and had passed through the cafeteria on his way to the mall. His 4th hour is at 10:20. He got back at about 11:10. He walked back in to the cafeteria by the student store. He usually waits for some friends, didn't see them. Those friends are Joseph Marino and Brian Blaskovich. He walked back outside the door by the student store. He saw a car that Joseph or Brian had been driving. That car was parked along Pierce Street in the Junior parking lot on the east side of the school. Tim didn't remember who's car it was or what it looked like. No one was in the car. Tim went back in through the same doors by the student store. He went in and sat at table X. Also sitting there were Tom Clagett, Dan Yager, Zack Thompson, Scott Streeb and Joe Tran.

Tim was sitting there talking to the others. Coach Sanders and a custodian ran in the door by the teacher's lounge. He said they were yelling for everyone to get down. Tim dropped down by his table. He heard one or two gun shots. They sounded like bang. Bang. He said that it didn't sound like an automatic, just the two shots. He said that the shots sounded like they were coming from outside, up on the hill. He said that he heard an explosion. He looked up and saw a big cloud in the parking lot, from out of the windows.

Tim said that all of a sudden, all the kids around stood up and started screaming and running toward the east side of the cafeteria. Tim said that he thinks when he got up, he tried to grab his back pack, and it may have ended up at another table.

Tim ran up the stairs to the top of the steps. One of the teachers came down and at the science hall, told the kids to calm

down. He then heard five gun shots right in a row, five quick shots. The shots sounded like they were coming from down stairs, like echoing from somewhere. He sprinted down the hall, going east. He went through the double doors and outside down the cement stairs. He said that he got out before the fire alarm went off. He went to Tom Clagett's house.

Tim never saw any shooter(s).

Tim said that he saw no duffel bags and no one carrying anything suspicious. He said that Eric Harris was in his gym class last semester, but Tim didn't know him. He knew Dylan Klebold by sight, but didn't see Dylan or Eric at school on Monday or Tuesday.

Tim left his Black Sport Plus back pack in the cafeteria. There was papers in it and a calculator.



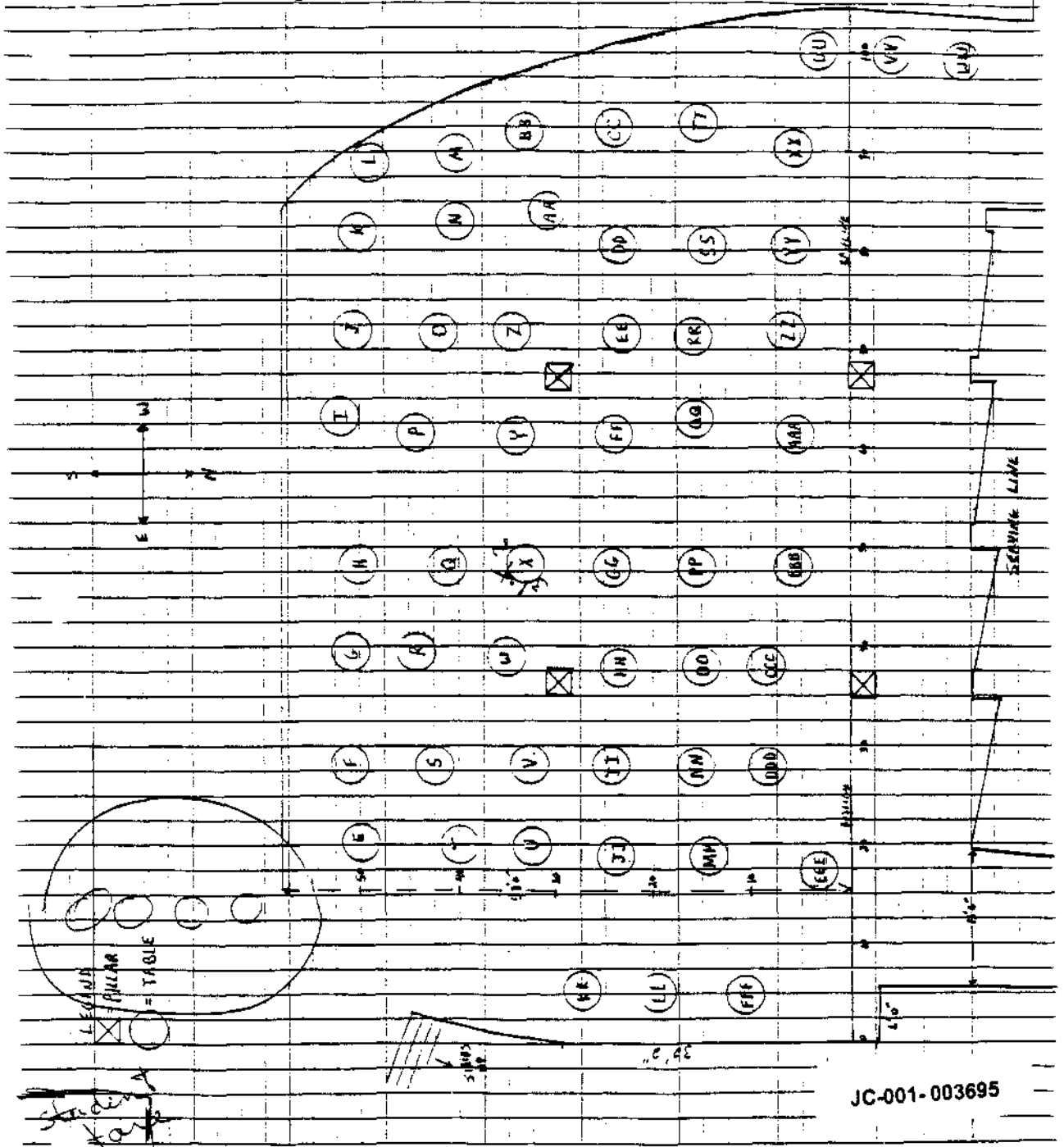

On May 7, 1999 at 1817 hours I contacted Alexis Mazula at her home for an interview. Her mother was present (lives in Brighton). Alexis then told me the following:

\* She is a freshman at Columbine High.

\* When asked, she did not know Eric Harris or Dylan Klebold by name or face.

\* [REDACTED]

\* She did not know [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] by face or name.

\* She has seen trench coat students hanging out at school. She usually saw them in the morning by the library or in front by the trophy case. She does not know any of their names. The only associates of the trench coat students she knows about are Brooks Brown who she said did hang out with some of the trench coat students, and a senior girl in her 6th hour guitar class who she thought knew Dylan and Eric. She did not know this girl's name but said she has brown hair and has a brother who is a freshman.

\* She never heard the name "Trench Coat Mafia" prior to the day of the shooting.

\* When asked, she said she did not see any of the trench coat students or their associates in school the day of the shooting. She did say that when people were getting down in the cafeteria she saw a male dressed all in black outside the cafeteria in the west lot. About 5 minutes later she saw a male all in black walking up toward the stairs outside the cafeteria. She did not know if it was the same person or not. She could not describe the person any further saying she just remembered black. She did not remember seeing if the person was holding anything.

\* When asked, she said she did not see any suspicious objects in school that day. When asked specifically, she said she did not see any duffle bags.

\* On the day of the shooting, her 4th hour class was choir. After getting out at 11:10 a.m. she went down to the cafeteria and put her backpack on a chair at a table there and went into the lunch line that was the farthest east line. Looking at the diagram, she thought the table was LL as she and her friends usually take the three tables in that area. The backpack list also showed her backpack recovered at table LL. She was in the lunch line with a Jennifer Naifeh.

\* After getting lunch, she returned to table LL and remembered the following students there also; Lindsay Dowling, Candace Cushman, Drew (last name unknown) and Ryan (last name unknown).

\* She then noticed that Mr. Sanders was running around the cafeteria in front of the west windows and then down along the food lines and was saying, "get down on the ground." She then heard an explosion and saw smoke out in the lot west of the cafeteria. She then heard reports like firecrackers.

\* She got down but looked up at times. She saw a male dressed all in black in the lot just west of the west windows walking toward the cafeteria. About 5 minutes later she saw a male dressed all in black going up by the stairs outside the cafeteria. She did not know if it was the same male and had no further description.

\* She thought from the sounds and student reactions that the male in black she saw may have had a gun, but she did not see any.


\* She then got her group to take off running. She ran upstairs, turned left down the hallway, and ran straight out the east door to that hallway. As she was running, she did hear what she thought were gunshots. She ran to Leawood Park and then around the neighborhood until she found a phone at a house.


\* She was wearing a black Calvin Klein shirt, jeans, and large platform shoes.

\* She said that the night of the shooting, she got on the Internet on AOL and pulled information off of Eric Harris' web site. She remembered seeing talk of bombs on that site. She gave that information to her father and step-mother. She does not know if they still have it. (Father and step-mother not home for this interview.)

\* She also heard sometime after the shooting students talking about Dylan Klebold telling a janitor on the day before the shooting to watch the news the next day, that a "big thing" was going to happen.
